<u>Draft emergency resolution on the instability in the Arab countries</u> and the attacks on western interests.

With regards to the recent turmoil caused by the release of an anti-Muslim film apparently made in the US, which caused a chain of disorder in several countries and led to the tragic assassination of a diplomat and other members of the US Consulate in Benghasi, Libya, the CDI:

- Emphatically condemns the death of these highly qualified civil servants, who were working to foster the democratic rights of Libyans.
- Urges the Libyan Authorities to work closely together to find the insurgent groups, who committed these attacks deliberately and with clear intentions.
- Calls on the perpetrators to cease the intentional attacks as soon as possible in the interests of the international community.
- Points out that freedom of religion is a value attached to the human being and this must be respected. In this sense the recent meeting with religious leaders in Beirut has proved that tolerance and solidarity between different beliefs is possible.
