

Resolution on nuclear proliferation

The CDI-IDC:

- Applauds the historical meeting, this 27 December 2016 at the Naval Base of Pearl Harbor, between US President Barack Obama and Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe, and the equally historical visit by President Obama to the city of Hiroshima on 25 May 2016;
- Underlines the fact that it is necessary to fully comprehend the gravity of the danger of nuclear war, knowing that existing international agreements, such as the various treaties on the reduction of strategic arms, are absolutely insufficient to containing the threat;
- Calls on the nations possessing such arms to be always faithful to the recommendations of the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT), which is the major tool for the regulation and control of nuclear arms, based on the principles of nonproliferation and the promotion of the peaceful uses of nuclear energy and disarmament;
- Praises the efforts of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), whose mission it is to keep watch over the application of these regulations.
