

Resolution on Yemen

Conscious of the festering conflict in Yemen and the growing instability resulting from it, the IDC-CDI:

- Expresses its grief and pain about regarding unnecessary deaths resulting from this conflict;
- Calls on the belligerent forces to put into effect an immediate cease-fire, with the objective of allowing free access to humanitarian assistance, without any restrictions, and seeking urgent measures of intermediation between the parties in view of realizing the relevant United Nations agencies on this issue;
- Implores the international community, and especially the United Nations, to immediately provide the humanitarian and economic means to put an end to this humanitarian tragedy, in view of the increasing famine and the precarious situation in which the civilian population finds itself;
- Deplores that recent efforts to mitigate the humanitarian situation has had no significant effect and that half of the promised humanitarian assistance has not yet been delivered;
- Calls for a diplomatic and political solution involving international organizations to mediate a swift resolution to this conflict.
