



## Resolution on Ukraine

The CDI:

**Reaffirms** respect to Ukraine's sovereignty, independence, unity and territorial integrity within its internationally recognized borders,

- 1. Welcomes** the Minsk II agreements as a step forward for peace, security and stability in the region.
- 2. Considers** that the Russia's support military aggression against Ukraine poses a threat to the international as well as regional peace and security as well as the flagrant violation of International Law,
- 3. Strongly condemns** the violations of ceasefire by militants acting in concert with Russian forces in Debaltseve and other areas of Donbas. Insists on immediate full access of Special Monitoring Missions of International Originations following the implementation of the Minsk agreements,
- 4. Calls on** the President of Russian Federation to exercise his influence on militants to enforce the ceasefire, to fully implement the Minsk agreements, to start the withdrawal all foreign troops and heavy weapons from the territory of Ukraine,
- 5. Regards** as unacceptable the continuing illegal detention in Russia of the deputy of Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine and a member of the Ukrainian delegation to the PACE Nadiya Savchenko, who was abducted from the territory of Ukraine. Expresses full support and join the call of the international community to immediately release Nadiya Savchenko and other Ukrainian citizens who remain illegally detained by the Russian Federation,
- 6. Urges** all parties to respect human rights, particularly with regard to the civilian population, and to monitor humanitarian organizations and NGO' s to assist the victims and people in need.
