

Resolution on the historic Middle East peace agreement.

The IDC-CDI joins in the expectations throughout the international community of the Abraham Agreements, which were sealed on September 15, 2020 in Washington, D.C. They consist of an agreement between Israel and the countries of the Gulf (UAE, Bahrain), mediated by the United States, which undoubtedly represent a hopeful step forward for the consolidation of diplomatic relations and a step towards political stability and peace in the area.

At the **IDC-CDI**, we are confident that this historic agreement will boost the region's economic growth, increase technological innovation and forge closer relations between its citizens.

The **IDC-CDI** assumes with hope and will that the declarations of the Prime Minister of Israel will be fulfilled, i.e. that "this peace will eventually expand to include other Arab states. And, ultimately, it can end the Arab-Israeli conflict once and for all."

The **IDC-CDI** hopes that the signing of this agreement will mark the beginning of a genuine and permanent path towards conciliation and will provide an opportunity for a round of negotiations with the Palestinian and Iranian authorities, with the aim of consolidating peace in the region.

The **IDC-CDI** recognises that this can represent a possibility for a solution to the Arab-Israel conflict based in the two-state solution.
