

Resolution on killings in Mali

IDC-CDI strongly condemns the cruel murder of at least 132 innocent people, most of them young, in unjustified and deplorable attacks by suspected jihadists in three locations in central Mali at the end of last June. We would like to convey our most sincere condolences to the people of Mali and especially to the families of the victims.

The Government charges the Katiba Marina group, also known as the Macina Liberation Front, with responsibility for the murders, IDC-CDI requests a thorough investigation leading to the maximum sentence and penalty for the masterminds, the collaborators, and the perpetrators themselves, through the appropriate judicial channels.

IDC-CDI demands that the Military Junta, which came to power through the 2020 coup d'état, restore sovereignty to the people of Mali through free and democratic elections, abandon power, and return to their camps.
